### **Abstract:**

This program protected and restored 734 acres of new wetland wildlife habitat in wetland complexes in Minnesota through fee title acquisition. Title of all lands acquired are held by the State and designated as Wildlife Management Area.

### **Activity Detail**

### **Design and Scope of Work:**

The Minnesota Statewide Conservation and Preservation Plan states that "Habitat fragmentation, degradation and loss are arguably the most important issues facing the conservation and preservation of Minnesota resources. Over 90% of Minnesota's prairie wetlands have been drained or filled, including 1,500 shallow wildlife lakes. Remaining wetlands and shallow lakes are in a degraded state and upland grass buffers have been largely converted to cropland. DNR acquired remaining and restorable wetlands and surrounding uplands in high priority wetland complexes as Wildlife Management Areas. Uplands have been or will be restored to native grassland buffers, wetlands have been or will be enhanced where possible and acquisitions will be developed to make them functional units in the outdoor recreation system. Collaborative partnerships were promoted in order to acquire key lands. DNR received a resolution from the County Board of Commissioners approving WMA acquisitions.

### **Sustainability and Maintenance:**

Lands acquired under this program were designated as State Wildlife Management Areas under authority of the Outdoor Recreation Act of 1978. Ongoing maintenance will be accomplished through routine management activities accomplished by our network of DNR offices. Periodic enhancements will be accomplished by existing staff, CCM crews, temporary project staffing or through vendor contract using traditional habitat project funding, bonding, and future requests for funding from dedicated funding sources. Payment in-lieu of tax payments are made to the counties from biennial appropriations by the Legislature from the general fund.

#### **Outcomes**

#### Programs in the northern forest region:

• Improved aquatic habitat indicators

#### Programs in forest-prairie transition region:

- Improved aquatic habitat indicators
- Increased availability and improved condition of riparian forests and other habitat corridors
- Protected, restored, and enhanced nesting and migratory habitat for waterfowl, upland birds, and species of greatest conservation need
- Wetland and upland complexes will consist of native prairies, restored prairies, quality grasslands, and restored shallow lakes and wetlands
- Water is kept on the land

### Programs in metropolitan urbanizing region:

- A network of natural land and riparian habitats will connect corridors for wildlife and species in greatest conservation need
- Protected habitats will hold wetlands and shallow lakes open to public recreation and hunting
