Dear Council members:

With regards to Review Criteria questions 7 and 8, Sandy was able to pull a very helpful report (attached) for all of the FY2017/ML2016 project proposals.

Within the report, columns 4 and 5 respectively refer to Review Criteria Questions 7 and 8. As these two questions are related to statutory requirements, an answer of “yes” indicates compliance and full point award.

In column 5 specifically, the answer refers to question 8 of the criteria, “The proposed restoration and enhancement is on land, or the land acquired, be permanently protected – protected either by public entity or federal tribal trust.” In this column an answer of “yes” indicates compliance. An answer of “N/A” indicates “not applicable” and that the question is not applicable since the project is not a restore/enhance project. An answer of “no” indicates non-compliance. Since there were zero “no” responses to either question 7 or 8, your scorings should indicate the following:

Question 7 – since all responses are “yes,” all projects should receive 6 points in your scoring.

Question 8 – “Yes” responses should receive 6 points. “No” responses, of which there are none, would naturally receive zero points. In the interest of uniform scoring, I am going to suggest that all “N/A” responses be given 6 points by all council persons. This is one of those questions that, before the Council uses it for the FY2018 Call for Requests, could use some verbiage and scoring tweaks. In the meantime, ensuring that all members score its responses in a uniform way will minimize ambiguities in score tallying.

We hope this report is helpful to you in your scoring. Please remember to have your scorings back to LSOHC staff **on or before Thursday, July 16th.**
